## POLICY: QUALIFICATIONS FOR SECTION OFFICERS

Approved by the Section Board of Directors 12 November 2014

1. **2<sup>ND</sup> VICE PRESIDENT:** In order to be nominated for the position of Section 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President, an individual must be a member in good standing of IMSA; and must have been a member of the Central Section for at least one (1) year.
2. **1<sup>ST</sup> VICE PRESIDENT:** In order to be nominated for the position of Section 1<sup>st</sup> Vice President, an individual must be a member in good standing of IMSA; and must have served as Central Section 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President. If there is no candidate that meets these qualifications, an individual may be nominated that has been a member in good standing of the Central Section for at least three (3) years.
3. **PRESIDENT:** In order to be nominated for the position of Section President, an individual must be a member in good standing of IMSA; and must have served as Central Section 1<sup>st</sup> Vice President or Central Section 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President.
4. **SECRETARY-TREASURER:** In order to be nominated for the position of Section Secretary-Treasurer, an individual must be a member in good standing of IMSA; must have been a member of the Central Section for at least five (5) years; and must have served as Central Section President, 1<sup>st</sup> Vice President or 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President.
5. **ALTERNATE DELEGATE:** In order to be nominated for the position of Section Alternate Delegate, an individual must be a member in good standing of IMSA; must have been a member of the Central Section for at least five (5) years; and must have served as Central Section President, 1<sup>st</sup> Vice President, or 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President, or served as the Section Certification Chair for at least two (2) years.
6. **DELEGATE:** In order to be nominated for the position of Section Delegate, an individual must be a member in good standing of IMSA; must have been a member of the Central Section for at least five (5) years; and must have served as Section Alternate Delegate. If there is no candidate that meets these qualifications, an individual may be nominated that is a member in good standing of the Central Section and has served as Central Section President, 1<sup>st</sup> Vice President, or 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President, or served as the Section Certification Chair for at least two (2) years.
